Water Rate Increase

During the June Board of Aldermen meeting Ordinance #399 was passed. This ordinance increases the water rate for residents that receive their water through the City of Hallsville.

The City of Hallsville purchases their water from PWSD#4 and distributes it to part of the residents within the city limits of Hallsville. After receiving an increase from PWSD#4, the City had to increase their water rates to keep up with the cost of water and the increase to maintain the water lines.

If you receive water from the City your water rates were \$13.35 for the first 1,000 gallons and \$5.30 for every 1,000 gallons after the first. The new water rates that you will see on your bill going out the end of June will be \$17.00 the first 1,000 gallons and \$7.50 for every 1,000 gallons after the first.
