three shelter locations within

The first shelter is the Hallsville Baptist Church located at 115 Elizabeth Street. Enter through the west door facing the parking lot.

The second shelter is the New Heights Church located at 408 N Route B. Enter through the rear door.

The third shelter is the Red Top Church located at 14355 N. Route U. Enter through the south door directly into the basement.
