The City of Hallsville, Missouri, was established as a fourth-class city in 1957. It operates under a Mayor-Aldermen-City Administrator governance structure. The Mayor, elected at-large for a two-year term, serves as the official head of the city and is permitted to cast a vote only in the event of a tie.

The Board of Aldermen consists of members elected from their respective wards, with two representatives from each ward. Ward 1 encompasses the area north of Route OO, extending west on Route 124, north on Bertie, and west to Route U. Ward 2 includes all areas situated south of Route OO. Board members serve two-year terms and are responsible for policymaking within the city's government.

Hallsville provides water services and street maintenance through its Public Works Department. The city has contracted trash services with Dayne's Waste Disposal. Residents can dispose of recyclables in the recycling bin located at the Hallsville Community Center, and bulky trash pick-up occurs on the third Wednesday of each month.

The administrative structure of the City of Hallsville includes the Office of the Mayor, the Office of the City Administrator, the Public Works Department, and the Hallsville Police Department. Further details regarding the services offered by these offices and departments will be provided later in this handbook.

Operating within its Board of Aldermen framework, the City of Hallsville remains responsive to the needs of its citizens. The primary objective of our elected officials is to embody a government that is by the people and for the people.

City Offices and Departments

Office of the Mayor (Telephone: 573-696-3885)

The Mayor is the Chief Executive Officer of the City of Hallsville. His or her duties include leading the Board of Aldermen meetings and when needed voting to break ties; attending meetings and gatherings to provide representation for our community and elected officials.

Office of the City Administrator (Telephone: 573-696-3885)

The Office of the City Administrator is comprised of the City Administrator/City Clerk and a Deputy Clerk. This office provides building applications to builders; accepts city utility payments; issues pet licenses; offers Notary Public; faxing and copying services to the community; is responsible for the handling of city funds; and providing decision-making services for the various departments when needed. This office also takes messages and relays them to the appropriate department heads.

Public Works Department (Telephone: 573-696-3885)

The Public Works Department is responsible for all maintenance, repair and testing of water lines owned and operated by the City, the repair, upgrade, cleaning and other maintenance of all buildings owned by or under the control of the City, the maintenance and repair of the City street system, the repair, upgrade and maintenance of the city park, and setback checks before dirt work is done on construction sites along with other inspections.

Hallsville Police Department

The Hallsville Police Department consists of a Police Chief, a Police Sergeant, two full time Officers, two part time Officers, and a full time School Resource Officer. The department is responsible for the public safety of our community. They also investigate criminal matters and enforce violations of federal, state and municipal codes and statutes. The department maintains a visible presence and strives to protect and serve the community at large.

Summary of Municipal Ordinances

Pet Ordinances

The City of Hallsville requires a license for all dogs and cats over the age of six months. Pet owners must show proof of an up-to-date rabies vaccination and pay a fee of \$3.00/year for those pets spayed/neutered and \$5.00/year for pets that have not been spayed/neutered. Municipal ordinance requires that the issued license be placed on the pet's collar. This allows the City to locate the owner should the police department pick up the pet. Pet tags are renewed in August of each year. Any person violating, neglecting or refusing to comply with the requirement to purchase a City animal license shall pay an additional fee of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars at the time the license exceeds 60 days past one (1) year. Dogs running at large are prohibited. If your dog is picked up or turned into the Police Department for running at large there is a boarding cost of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each day. The fee is in effect at the moment of collection of the dog(s) and is in addition to the citation the owner will receive upon claiming of the animal.

Barking, annoying dogs are not allowed. Ordinances also require proper food and water, proper shelter from the elements, and proper care of pets. A <u>maximum number of four pets</u> (cats, dogs, or cats and dogs) are allowed per household.

Public Nuisances

The City of Hallsville has a comprehensive public nuisance ordinance designed to protect the rights of property owners within our city by prohibiting certain actions that would create unacceptable conditions for surrounding area residents. A complete copy of this ordinance is available for viewing at City Hall.

The following is a short list of some of the areas affected by this ordinance. All motor vehicles must be currently licensed. Accumulations of trash, leaves, grass, or other items are not allowed. No outside storage of appliances. No maintaining any odor emitting substance and no outside bathrooms are allowed. Pools of water are not allowed, nor is the growth of grass and weeds allowed to exceed 7 inches in height.

Other Ordinance Information

The City of Hallsville has ordinances regulating the maximum speed allowed on its streets. That information is posted on street signs. Loud, excessive, unnecessary noise is not allowed. The City has ordinances dealing with a number of criminal violations such as stealing, property damage, trespassing, assault and possession of marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Hallsville Municipal Court

Hallsville Municipal Court has been transferred to the Boone County Circuit Court. Municipal court date is the second Tuesday after the first Monday each month at 9:00 a.m. at the Boone County Courthouse located at 705 East Walnut, Columbia, MO (unless otherwise ordered). Fine payments may not be accepted any earlier than 15 days from the issue date of the ticket. Mailing address for tickets: Boone County Clerk 705 E. Walnut St., Columbia, MO 65201. Trash Pick-up

Dayne's Waste Disposal Inc. is the approved residential waste collector for the City of Hallsville. Trash pickup is Wednesday.

- If your trash can is larger than <u>44 gallons</u>: NO loose trash in can, everything must be bagged; bags must be 13 gallon bags or larger and weigh less than 50 lbs.
- Trash cans *less than 44 gallons*: cannot exceed 50 lbs to be dumped as normal.

Trash should be at the curb the evening before. Trash rates are \$15.80 a month.

There is a *recycling bin* located at the Community Center, 324 E. Hwy OO, that you can take plastics, aluminum, tin, glass, newspapers, office waste, paper & magazines, and cardboard. Cardboard: Remove all contents. Please flatten. NO STYROFOAM PACKING MATERIAL

City of Hallsville Water and Trash Services

Bills are due by the 10th of each month. A **5%** late fee is assessed on the 11th. Accounts that are not paid by the 20th of the month will be assessed a **\$35.00** non-payment fee and services will be subject to disconnection. To restore service the City shall require all past due fees, interest, and non-payment fees paid in full. In addition, a fee of **\$25.00** for having such service restored during regular business hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. each working day, Monday through Friday. You can pay your City bill by coming into City Hall with cash, check, money order or a debit/credit card. There is a night deposit box where you can leave your payment, we take debit/credit cards over the phone, or you can pay your account online (Hallsvillemo.org) with a debit/credit card with your account number. If you would prefer to pay your bill through ACH (automatic payment withdrawals from your bank account) we would be happy to provide you with an application to set up your payments. If you use a debit/credit card in person, over the phone, or online there is a 'convenience fee' of 2.75% or a minimum of \$2.75 per transaction.

Daniel Boone Bookmobile

The bookmobile serves Hallsville the 2^{nd} and 4^{th} Tuesday every month. The bookmobile parks in the City Hall parking lot and is open from 2:00 P.M. - 7:00 P.M.

Civil Defense Siren Testing

Tribble Park

Tribble Park is located on Route OO and is owned by the City of Hallsville. The park opens in March and closes in October each year. Park hours are from sunrise to sunset daily. Shelter houses may be rented for \$20.00 through City Hall. No alcohol or drugs are allowed in the park.

Hallsville Community Center

The Community Center can be rented through City Hall for \$125.00 per day (\$50.00 for non-profit groups) and a \$100.00 security deposit.

The consumption of intoxicating liquor and alcoholic beverages shall only be allowed after the execution of a rental agreement with and the issuance of a permit. The rental agreement shall be executed after proper review of a State license to sell intoxicating liquor by the drink, where drinks will be offered for sale during the proposed event and as otherwise required by State law.

Renters shall be required to provide to the City a copy of an insurance certificate in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence and one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) aggregate and one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) in host liquor liability naming the City of Hallsville as an additional insured before they are permitted to host an event at City property wherein alcoholic beverages and intoxicating liquors shall be served, provided, or otherwise present.
