# HALLSVILLE NEWS & VIEWS

- July 2<sup>nd</sup>: Emergency sirens are tested the first Wednesday of every month at noon.
- July 4th: City Hall will be closed to observe Independence Day.
- July 10<sup>th</sup>: Accounts signed up for automatic withdraw payments for City water and/or trash will have payments remove your checking account.
- July 11th: A 5% penalty is added to all water and/or trash accounts that are unpaid.
- July 14<sup>th</sup>: The Board of Aldermen have their regular monthly meeting at 7:00 p.m. in City Hall.
- July 21st: A \$35 nonpayment fee will be added to all water and/or trash accounts that are unpaid. Services will be discontinued. Needing help with your bill? Call City Hall before the 21st to make a payment arrangement.

#### Fireworks Reminders for Hallsville Residents

As Independence Day approaches, the City of Hallsville wants to remind residents of the rules surrounding the use of fireworks within city limits.

#### **Permitted Fireworks Use**

Residents may legally discharge fireworks between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. from June 28 through July 4 each year.

#### **Restrictions on Aerial Fireworks**

Fireworks that are propelled or shot into the air—such as bottle rockets, roman candles, and similar devices—are only permitted on July 4th between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. These types of fireworks are prohibited at all other times, even during the allowed discharge week.

#### **Special Events**

Public fireworks displays must be pre-approved and permitted by the Hallsville Chief of Police. These events must follow strict safety guidelines and be supervised at all times.

We encourage everyone to celebrate safely and respect the law to ensure a fun and injury-free holiday for all!

#### **DOG & CAT LICENSE RENEWED IN AUGUST**

🐾 HALLSVILLE'S PET ORDINANCES – WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW! 🐾

The City of Hallsville loves our four-legged friends—but we also have a few important rules in place to help keep pets and neighbors safe!

#### **Pet Licensing Required:**

All dogs and cats over 6 months of age must be licensed with the City. To get a license, pet owners must show proof of current rabies vaccination. Fees are: \$3.00 per year for spayed/neutered pets and \$5.00 per year for pets that are not spayed/neutered. Licenses must be renewed each August and attached to your pet's collar. This helps the Police Department return lost pets quickly and safely.



🚨 Late License Penalty: Licenses more than 60 days overdue past one year (after October 31st) will be subject to a \$25 late fee. No Dogs Running at Large: Dogs must remain on their property or on a leash. If your dog is picked up by the Police Department, there's a \$50/day boarding fee—plus a citation. Name Barking & Annoying Dogs: Pets that create a nuisance, including excessive barking, are not allowed. 🦮 Proper Pet Care is Required: Hallsville ordinances require that all pets have: Fresh food and water, adequate shelter from weather, and general care and attention. 🏠 Pet Limit Per Household: Households may have no more than four dogs and/or cats.

# Recreational Vehicle Permits Renewed in August




Recreational Vehicle Permits are renewed every August for utility vehicles, golf carts, and recreational off-highway vehicles operated on City roadways.

Permit Period: Valid from September 1 to August 30 each year. S Cost: \$15.00

per vehicle

🚔 Required Inspection: All vehicles must be inspected by the Chief of Police or his designee before a permit is issued.

**Operator Requirements:** A valid driver's or chauffeur's license is required to operate a permitted vehicle on public roads. Exception: Handicapped individuals operating such vehicles occasionally for short distances do not need a motorcycle endorsement.
