Trash Reminders!

Trash pick-up is Wednesday and should be set out at curbside the night before. **NO** yard waste, brush, or construction debris allowed in your trash collection. *Remember:* Dayne's no longer dumps trash cans larger than 44 gallons. If your container is larger than 44 gallons everything must be in bags. Bags must be 13 gallon or larger and weigh 50 lbs. or less. Trash cans 44 gallons or less will still be dumped as normal as long as they don't exceed 50lbs. Bulky Trash Information: Bulky trash items include furniture, mattresses, and other sizable waste material that two men can lift. Refrigerators, ice makers, and window air conditioners need a certificate from a technician certifying removal of Freon from the appliance.
